How to Login to the Dashboard

WordPress is an excellent platform for clients who want to manage their own websites without being held captive by a web developer. Once the website is built you can add, edit or remove any content you wish, from anywhere, on any device without any special software. This tutorial will show you how to manage your blog and add articles.

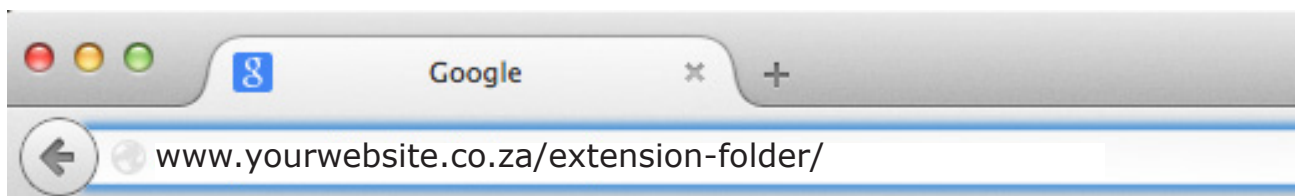
Step 1 - Getting to your Dashboard

The dashboard is the 'back-end' of the website where all the magic happens. To get here you need to first navigate to your website.

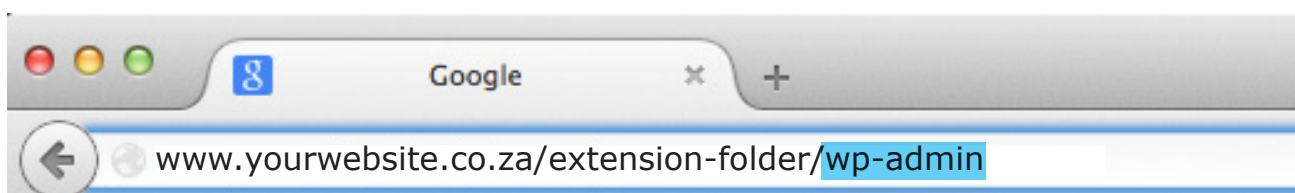
Enter the normal web address of your website in the URL or address bar at the top left side of your browser. If you cannot see this bar then go to your browser settings under "View" to activate this bar because you need it.



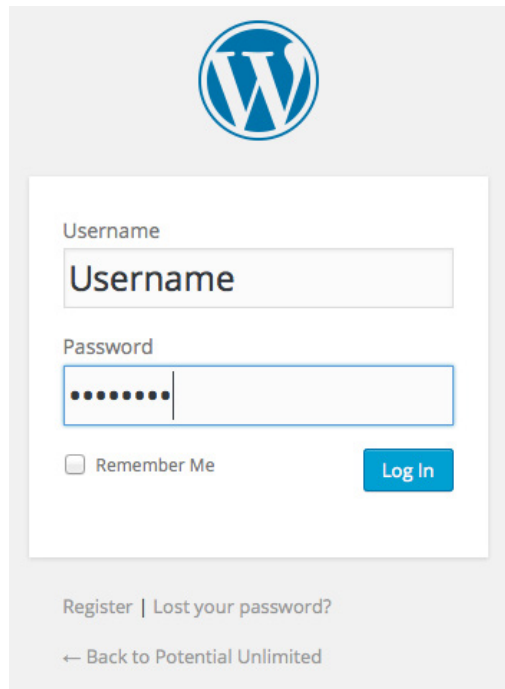
Once your site has loaded, the title may show an extra extension to the URL but this is normal. This helps a lot with google searching and allows future upgrades to your site without interfering with the existing one. It's advisable to keep the extension, it will not make a difference to you or the user.



Next you need to enter the following after the last '/' sign: wp-admin
Exactly like the example below.



You will arrive at the login page where you need to enter the username and password provided to you.



When you see this page then you are logged in to the dashboard
